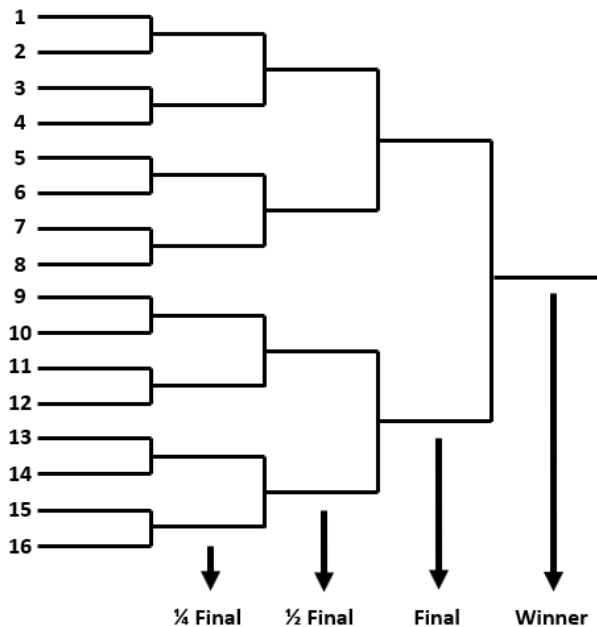
4x4 Shootout Race

Regulations 4x4 Shootout Race

- §1 The 4x4 Shootout Race is a competitive event for off-road vehicles and is driven in heavy terrain. The use of the winch is not allowed.
- §2 The **starting position** for the qualifying will be drawn by lot. There is a maximum of 16 start slots.
- §3 **Shootout Race:** A maximum of 16 vehicles start in the knockout procedure. Two vehicles start at the same time on a marked track. The one who is faster reaches the next round.

§5 A section is a marked and delimited section of terrain, which is identified by beginning and end gates, as well as lateral boundaries.

§6 Any assistance is considered outside assistance.

§7 Each participant is obliged to help in case of emergency both inside and outside the competition.

- §8** Outside the sections and the circuit, driving must be at walking speed. **Non-compliance will be punished with disqualification.**
- §9** Riding out/car surfing is not permitted for safety reasons. Belaying only with recovery harness or spotter rope.
- §10** Participants who endanger others through gross negligence or willful misconduct will be excluded from the event.
- §11** Personal injuries, corridor and environmental damages have to be reported to the organizer immediately.
- §12** The orders and instructions of the organizer and his helpers must be followed during the entire event. Failure to follow instructions may result in the imposition of penalty times or disqualification and exclusion from the event. If a competitor gives up, he is obliged to inform the organizers immediately.
- §13** All participating vehicles must undergo an equipment and decal inspection to verify compliance with the sponsor decal schedule and the presence of mandatory equipment

For all classes:

- helmet
- fire extinguisher
- recovery strap, shackle and recovery point on vehicle
- roll cage on open top vehicles
- divider if radiator, battery, fuel tank or similar components are inside the passenger compartment

Vehicles without completed mandatory equipment or with third-party advertising not removed or passed over will be excluded from the event even with a valid entry.

For an additional charge, the vehicle may not be covered with sponsor stickers. The start number as well as the class identification must always be attached according to the sticker plan.

- §14** The erection of advertising banners, flags, etc. and the distribution/display of flyers is only permitted after consultation with the organizer.
- §15** Participants may not be under the influence of alcohol or other substances, such as medication or intoxicants, which may impair the roadworthiness of the participants, during the scoring runs. Driving vehicles under the influence of alcohol or other substances, such as medication or intoxicants, which may impair the roadworthiness of the participants, is prohibited at all times.
- §16** Participants (driver and co-driver) must be of legal age (18 years), the driver must hold a driving license valid for the vehicle he is driving.
- §17** Only Maximilian Neumaier and Maximilian Geldhauser are responsible for complaints, claims or other concerns. Questions about regulations and scoring will not be answered by the helpers and marshals.
